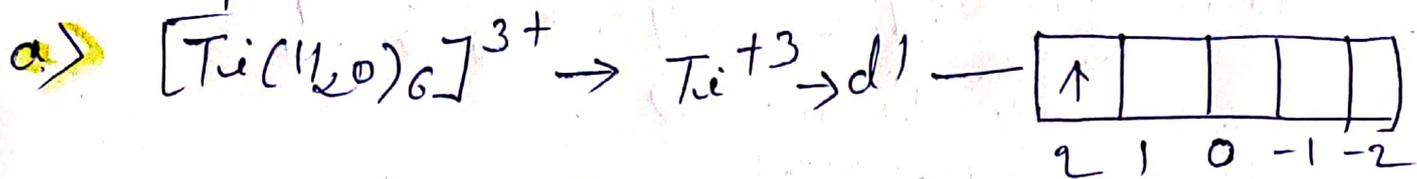


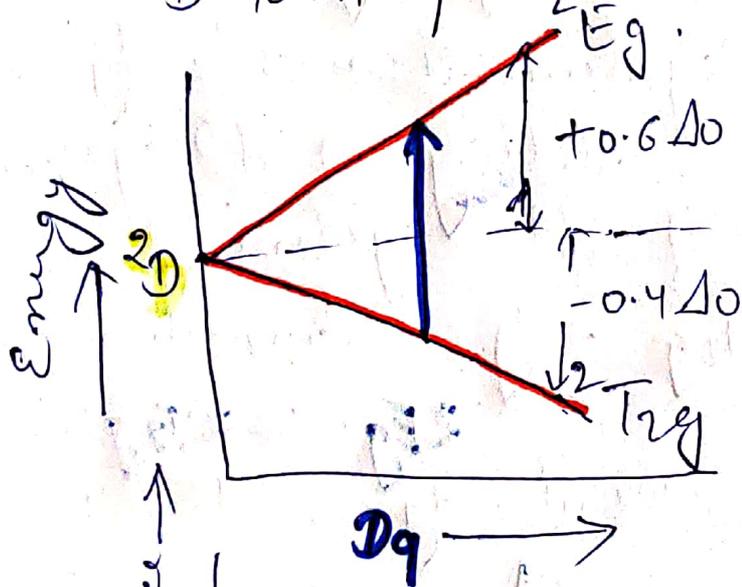

Term symbol — $L = 2 \therefore \text{Term} = D$

Spin multiplicity $2S + 1 = 2 \times \frac{1}{2} + 1 = 2$
 $= 2D$

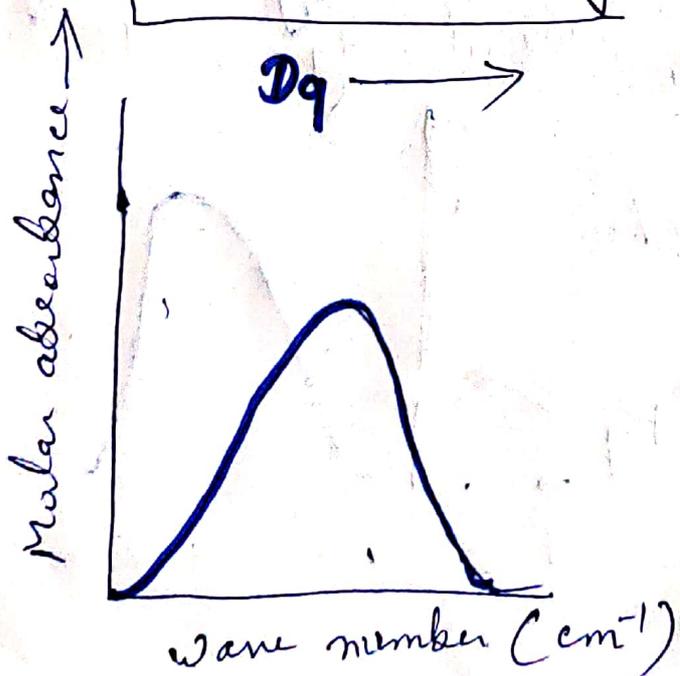
$2D$ Term split into T_{2g} & E_g .

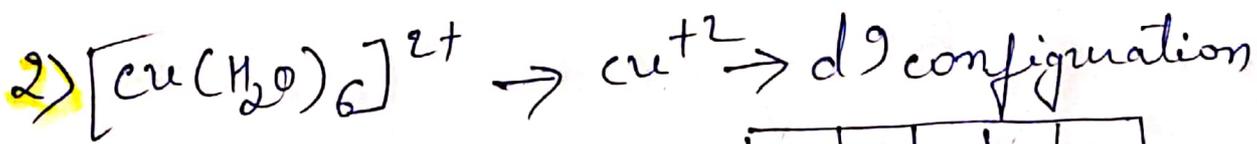


only one transition



\therefore we get only one peak in spectra.

Term symbol - $L = 6 - 4 = 2$, $S = \frac{1}{2}$

\therefore Term = D

Spin multiplicity = $2S + 1$

$$= 2 \times \frac{1}{2} + 1 = 2$$

Term symbol **2D**

Splitting of 2D $\rightarrow {}^2T_{2g} + {}^2E_g$

Since in d^9 system there is only one whole therefore splitting of d^9 system is just inverse of d^1 system:
