Committee finds that total 671 students have participated in the survey. 551 students were from bachelor degree course and 89 students were from master degree course. 480 students were from arts and humanity faculty, 139 students were from science faculty and 40 students were from commerce faculty.
2. >90% students (90%) said that 55-100% syllabus was covered during the academic year 2023-24, among such students >50% student said the 85-100% syllabus was covered during the academic year 2023-2024.


Count of 1. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?






Count of 3. How well were the teachers able to communicate?




Count of 5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers.


Count of 12. The teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications.




Count of 13. The teachers identify your strengths and encourage you with providing right level of challenges.



Count of 14. Teachers are able to identify your weaknesses and help you to overcome them.




